



Park Hill School District Education Foundation, Inc. Staff Frequently Asked Questions

In keeping with the mission of the Park Hill Education Foundation's mission to provide funds to enhance academic excellence within the Park Hill School District, the Foundation is pleased to provide the InvestNOW grants program. The purpose of the program is to facilitate community involvement through online grant opportunities for our educators.

What kinds of proposals will be funded through Invest Now?

Proposals should enhance or improve the educational experience for our students. Programs or projects should be innovative and use creative learning and teaching techniques. Grant proposals must meet the requirements set forth in the grant application.

What is the dollar minimum and maximum for the grants?

The minimum amount is \$50. There is no maximum dollar limit.

What will be the deadline for the application?

Teachers may submit at any time throughout the year.

Can I apply for an Invest Now Grant and a Foundation Classroom Grant at the same time?

Yes. It is recommended you apply for both.

What is the process to submit an Invest Now Grant?

The application is not as extensive as the Classroom Grant Application. However, there is specific criteria that must be met. If the grant is for any technology related items an additional application must be submitted. The entire process is online. You will submit your application to your principal. Once your principal approves the grant it will be submitted to the Foundation. The Foundation will then distribute it to the appropriate departments for final approval. At that time the grant will go on the Foundation website.

What happens when my proposal gets funded?

An account will be established through the district and we will give you details on how to access the funds. You will need to submit a report that will be sent to the donor(s) and posted on the website.
